OR Ranking based on Qualifying Round scores  
Official OR to be held with a 4 shooter minimum.  
(Possible practice round of mixed groups for divisions without 4 shooter minimum.)

"Junior" through the calendar year of their 18th birthday (Born in or after 1986).  
"Cadet" through the calendar year of their 16th birthday (Born in or after 1988).

Junior 70 Meters  
Cadet Male 70 Meters  
Cadet Female 60 Meters  
Olympic Round will be at 70 meters – Ranking based on Qualifying Round scores
