

# 2006 ARIZONA COLLEGIATE OUTDOOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

**Saturday – April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2006 NAA 900 Round**

**SCHEDULE:** **Saturday, April 15<sup>th</sup>** (tentative – assumes that Western Regionals will be held on the weekend of the 21<sup>st</sup> – 23<sup>rd</sup>)

**FORMAT:** We're bringing back the 900 round for this tournament. The 900 Round is perfect for newer shooters who may not be able to get the longer distances, or who simply don't have the courage or time invested in shooting them... and yet, the cream will rise to the top. For those of you who are unfamiliar with the 900 round, archers (male and female) shoot 60, 50, and 40 meters at the 144 cm face. 30 arrows are shot at each distance in 6 arrow ends (the timing is just like a FITA).

**DIVISIONS:**

**Collegiate -** Men and Women: Recurve, Compound  
**Guests -** Space permitting.

- Adult Compound, Adult Recurve (men and women duke it out)
- JOAD Compound, JOAD Recurve (14 - 18 at the time of the tournament, boys and girls combined – no separate JOAD distances or classifications).
- Special JOAD: If space allows (and this will be a last minute decision), we will allow JOADs ages 13 and under to shoot special short distances at no charge (though donations to cover target costs will be accepted).

**AWARDS:** Awards will be given for 1<sup>st</sup>- 5<sup>th</sup> place in the collegiate divisions. There will be NO awards for Adults or JOADs.
