ASAA INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT: Double FITA I - Indoor 18 meter Tournament (Star FITA)

Recurve Bow and Barebow – Two (2) – 600 rounds from 18 meters; - 40 cm target face (choice of single-spot, triangle or vertical three-spot face — must use choice for entire tournament); outer 10 ring scoring. (Double 600 round = 60 arrows x 2 rounds = 120 arrows)

Compound Bow- Two (2) - 600 rounds from 18 meters; - 40 cm target face (choice of single spot, triangle or vertical three-spot face — must use choice for entire tournament); all compounds use inner 10 ring scoring regardless of age. (Double 600 round = 60 arrows x 2 rounds = 120 arrows) (60 Pound draw weight maximum as measured by the Tournament scale)

Target Face – All archers use a 40cm target face, regardless of age or category.

MEMBERSHIP – USAA/NAA membership listing Arizona residence is required to compete for the State Championship. If your USAA membership expires prior to the official start date of the tournament, a copy of your USAA membership renewal and payment must accompany your tournament Registration Form. Your application will not be considered complete until your current membership is on file with the USAA. Please be prepared to show USAA membership card at the tournament registration table or be prepared to purchase a USAA membership **USA Archery - NAA Membership** at that time.

USAA rules apply. <u>Equipment and Arrow size limitations per USAA Rules and Regulations.</u>
FITA Indoor Arrow: "8.3.1.7.1 An arrow consists of a shaft with head (point) nock, fletching and, if

desired, cresting. The maximum diameter of arrow shafts will not exceed 9.3mm; the heads (points) for these arrows may have a maximum diameter of 9.4mm. All arrows of every athlete must be marked with the athlete's name or initials on the shaft, and all arrows used at any end will carry the same pattern and colour(s) of fletching, nocks and cresting, if any".
