2010 Arizona Cup is a World Ranking Tournament

<u>How to Register:</u> You may print the form and mail-in with your payment (or) you may register and pay online with a credit card. Go to link shown on www.arizonacup.com to download forms.

Entry Fee: \$125 / Adult or Junior, \$100 / Cadet, payable in US dollars.

<u>Deadline:</u> Must be <u>received by March 25, 2010</u> – Space is limited to the field capacity so register early. Registrations received after March 25 will be assessed a late fee. There is no on-site registration.

<u>Late Fee:</u> add \$35.00 US, if registration will be received after March 25. Late entries will be accepted in order received as field capacity permits.

<u>Cancellations:</u> Through March 25 will receive a full refund. A \$35 fee will be withheld after March 25. Email notification of cancellation is acceptable. <u>No refunds after April 1, 2010</u>.

<u>Waiver:</u> All archers must sign a liability and photo waiver prior to participating in tournament activities. Archers under 18 years of age must also have a parent or legal guardian sign the waiver.

<u>USAT and Junior USAT Qualifier:</u> USA Archery has selected the AZ Cup as one of their qualifiers. USAT requirements and ranking information may be found at http://archery.teamusa.org/.

2010 Format:

- Qualification Round: Double 72 arrow Rounds, (Total =144 arrows at 70m for Adults and Juniors, or 60m for Cadets)
- Only archers shooting 70m are eligible for Team Rounds and Individual Elimination Round. Junior ranking will be combined with the Adult ranking for individual elimination or team rounds.
- Ranking for the Individual Elimination and Mixed and National Team Rounds will be based on the total Qualification Round. Ranking for the Open Team Round will be based on the first 72 arrows.
- The Elimination Round will be utilizing the Set System per FITA April 1, 2010 rules.
- Cadets are not eligible for the team or individual elimination rounds.

2010 Rules:

- USAA and FITA rules, including dress codes. All archers must wear appropriate footwear including sport shoes covering the foot. (FITA, Book 1, 3.22.1.2) Note that sport sandals are not acceptable.
- There are many new rules going into affect on April 1, 2010 and the AZ Cup will be one of the first using these new rules.

Categories: New for 2010 to accommodate USAT criteria

- Recurve and Compound Men (shooting 70 meters)
- Recurve and Compound Women (shooting 70 meters)
- Recurve and Compound Junior Men (shooting 70 meters)
- Recurve and Compound Junior Women (shooting 70 meters)
- Recurve and Compound Cadet Men (shooting 60 meters)(Not eligible for Elimination or Team Rounds)
- Recurve and Compound Cadet Women (shooting 60 meters) (Not eligible for Elimination or Team Rounds)



National Team Round and Mixed National Team Round:

Only those archers designated by their country in the Team Meeting may compete in any of the national team rounds. Only those categories with two or more teams will be contested. A country may enter one team each in Men Recurve, Men Compound, Women Recurve and Women Compound National Team Rounds. A country may enter one Mixed Team each for Recurve and Compound.

Open Teams:

Arizona Cup Open Team Round is included in the registration. Deadline to register an open team is 10:45am on Friday, April 9th. Open Team Competition will be held on Friday afternoon, April 9th. Open teams are typically corporate teams, collegiate teams or other, including teams arranged at the field by open competitors. No mixed open teams.

Coaches during Practice and Qualification:

Personal coaches are not allowed in the archer's area during qualification scoring. Personal coaches must stay behind the spectator line during scoring. Personal coaches are allowed up to the waiting line during practice. Credentialed National Team Coaches are allowed up to the waiting line during scoring and may sit in the archer's tents.

Coaches (during Elimination Rounds):

Personal coaches and Credentialed National Team Coaches are allowed up to the waiting line during practice and during scoring and may be in the archer's tents. Seating is reserved for the archers. No more than one coach per archer may be at the waiting line during elimination matches.

Agents: Credentialed persons assisting AR archers or the tournament officials may sit in the archer's tents.

<u>Photographers:</u> Must be credentialed (max. of 4) by the tournament to be allowed at the waiting line/photo lane, in blinds or down range.

Shade and Seating:

- Shade canopies and seating will be provided for the archers.
- Complimentary shade and bleacher seating is provided for spectators.
- Spectators may erect their own shade canopies and seating behind the designated line and must be securely staked down.

Awards: Awards will be given to the finalists of the elimination round. No qualification awards.

Ground Transportation Options:

- Rental Car (all PHX terminals have shuttle service to/from the Rental Car Facility)
- Airport to/from Hotel: Light Rail and then complimentary pick-up by Hotel van from the Light Rail station.
- Airport to/from Hotel: SuperShuttle Details. (See tournament website)
- Airport to/from Hotel: ExecuCar Details (meet and greet service and 10 passenger vans with driver are available) (See tournament website)
- Complimentary van transportation from Hotel to/from Venue. (space is limited)
- Hotel also provides complimentary transportation within a five mile radius of the Hotel.

Airport: PHX = Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport – 17 miles to the Host Hotel and 34 miles to the tournament venue.

<u>Drug Testing:</u> Any archer may be subject to unannounced drug testing. Refusal to test may lead to disqualification. Request information from USADA or, if you have questions.
