Who: All youth archers as well as adults interested in outdoor practice for Arizona JOAD Outdoor Championship, AAE AZ Cup and other events.

What: Practice and training at all FITA distances.

Where: Ben Avery Shooting Facility FITA range, Phoenix (NWC Carefree Hwy and I-17)

When: Sundays in March and April 14th, 2013. Arrive between 8am and 10am. Session ends around mid-day. Dates, additional dates and times subject to change, based on interest.

How: Archers are welcome borrow a USA Archery AZ target matt and stand for free. This is a self serve program. Each archer sets up and takes down and put away the target matt, stand and equipment each session.

Why: JOAD practice for USA Archery Arizona JOAD Outdoor Championship and EJA. Adult practice for AAE Arizona Cup and National Target Championship. This program enables archers to set up targets at any and all distances. Note that BASF FITA practice range is available.

How Much: Youth age 17 and under are free: Adults age 18 and older, pay BASF daily fee. Donations welcomed.
