Who: All archers interested in outdoor practice for Arizona State Outdoor Championship, AAE AZ Cup and other events.

What: Desert Sky Archery, USAA-Arizona and Corner Kids JOAD are putting on an Outdoor Practice and Training opportunity.

Where: Ben Avery Shooting Facility FITA range, Phoenix (NWC Carefree Hwy and I-17)

When: Sundays March 23, April 13th and Saturday, April 19th. Setup begins at 7:00am, Shooting From 8:00am to 2:00pm, tear down 2:00 to 3:00pm. Additional dates and times are subject to change, based on interest.

How: Archers are welcome borrow a USA Archery AZ target matt and stand for free. This is a self serve program. Each archer sets up and takes down and put away the target matt, stand and equipment each session.

Why: JOAD practice for USA Archery Arizona State Outdoor Championship and EJN. Adults practice for AAE Arizona Cup and National Target Championship. This program enables archers to set up targets at any and all distances. Note that BASF FITA practice range is available.

How Much: Youth age 17 and under are free: Adults age 18 and older, pay BASF daily fee \$6.00. Donations welcomed. Check-in at the Fita Field is available, but please have correct change. If archers will want to shoot on other Ben Avery Venues, you will need to check-in at the Clay Target Center.
