ALL MAILED REGISTRATIONS NEED TO ARRIVE BY SEPT 28 TO AVOID LATE FEE

Late registration is subject to LATE FEE on a space available basis using existing target set-up and a shooting assignment cannot be guaranteed. Registration must be completed in full.

LOCATION: Ben Avery Shooting Facility, FITA Range, Phoenix, Arizona

TOURNAMENT RULES: USA ARCHERY including USAA [dress code](#) and new FITA rules effective April 1, 2011 will be enforced.

CHAMPIONSHIP ELIGIBILITY: USA Archery membership listing Arizona as your residence is required for you to compete for State Championship titles and awards. Guests (Non-USAA and/or Non-Arizonans) are welcome to shoot in a guest category.

CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS: Awards will be distributed for the Arizona State Outdoor Championship based on the number of actual participants in the category using the following awards structure:

- **Up to 2 participants:** 1st place only
- **3 - 4 participants:** 1st and 2nd place only
- **5 or more:** 1st, 2nd and 3rd places
- **JOAD categories:** 1st, 2nd, 3rd places
- **Guest categories:** no awards

QUALIFICATION ROUND: **144 arrow Qualification Round will determine the State Champions**

- All Seniors and Juniors will shoot a four distance FITA. (90/70m, 70/60m, 50m, 30m) (Men/Women distances)
- All Masters and Cadets will shoot a four distance FITA. (70/60m, 60/50m, 50/40m, 30m) (Men/Women distances)
- All Cubs will shoot a four distance FITA. (50m, 40m, 30m, 20m)
- All Bowmen will shoot a four distance FITA. (30m, 25m, 25m, 20m)
- All 1st day distances will be on a 122cm face and 2nd day 1st round for Recurve and Bowman Compound will shoot 10 ring 80cm face. All classes will shoot 6 ring 80cm for final round. Tournament may permit 10 ring target on a case by case basis.
- All ends are 4 minute, 6 arrow ends.
- Guests are welcome to shoot in a Guest category.

SHADE AND CHAIRS: There will be shade for Archers and Spectators; however you should bring your own chairs. There is bleacher seating for Spectators.

WHEELCHAIR ATHLETES: Please contact the tournament and provide requirements so target assignments can be correct.

I understand the nature of **The National Archery Association of the US** activities and acknowledge my experience and capabilities and believe I am/my minor child is qualified to participate in such Activity. I further acknowledge that I am aware that the activity will be conducted in facilities open to the public during the Activity. I further agree and warrant that if, at any time, I believe conditions to be unsafe, I will immediately discontinue further participation in the Activity.
2. I FULLY UNDERSTAND that:

2012 Arizona Duel in the Desert Team Selection Guidelines

1. Arizona Duel's Team participants must be registered for the Trials before competition scoring begins.
2. ASAA Board reserves the right to fill vacant team positions.
3. Must be a USAA member with Arizona listed residence.
4. Men's trials competitors may compete in Master, Senior, Junior or Cadet Championship Categories only. Total score of 70+50+30 meters will be used for Senior and Junior Team Trials ranking.
5. Women's trials competitors may compete in Master, Senior, Junior or Cadet Championship Categories. Total score of 60+30 meters will be used for Senior and Junior Team Trials ranking.
6. Top Duel trials competitor championship scores will be used to rank and select the AZ Duel Team.
7. Men's AZ Duel Team 2012: 4 Compound Senior, 6 Recurve Senior, 1 Compound Junior, 1 Recurve Junior.
8. Women's AZ Duel Team 2012: 4 Compound Senior, 6 Recurve Senior, 1 Compound Junior, 1 Recurve Junior.
9. Each archer making the Duel Team will have their entry into the Duel in the Desert paid and receive an AZ Duel Team shirt.
10. The AZ Duel Team will compete in the Duel in the Desert on November 10-11, 2012 at the Ben Avery FITA Range and represent the Arizona State Archery Association and USA Archery in keeping with the USA Archery code of conduct.
