USAA-ARIZONA INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT: Double FITA I - Indoor 18 meter Tournament (Star FITA)

Recurve Bow and Barebow – Two (2) – 600 rounds from 18 meters; - 40 cm target face (choice of single-spot, triangle or vertical three-spot face — must use choice for entire tournament); outer 10 ring scoring. (Double 600 round = 60 arrows x 2 rounds = 120 arrows)

Compound Bow- Two (2) - 600 rounds from 18 meters; - 40 cm target face (choice of single spot, triangle or vertical three-spot face — must use choice for entire tournament); all compounds use inner 10 ring scoring regardless of age. (Double 600 round = 60 arrows x 2 rounds = 120 arrows) (60 Pound draw weight maximum as measured by the Tournament scale)

Target Face – All archers use a 40cm target face, regardless of age or category.

<u>MEMBERSHIP:</u> USAA/NAA membership listing Arizona residence is required to compete for the State Championship recognition. If your USAA membership expires prior to the official start date of the tournament, a copy of your USAA membership renewal and payment must accompany your tournament Registration Form. Your application will not be considered complete until your current membership is on file with the USAA. Please be prepared to show USAA membership card at the tournament registration table or be prepared to purchase a USAA membership at that time. - 3. ***USAA Dress Code will be enforced...this includes official practice sessions***
- 4. Arrow Requirements (World Archery, Book 3):
 - 11.1.7. Arrows of any type may be used provided they comply with the common meaning of the word "arrow" as used in target archery, and do not cause undue damage to target faces or butts.
 - 11.1.7.1. An arrow consists of a shaft with a tip (point), nocks, fletching and, if desired, cresting. The maximum diameter of arrow shafts shall not exceed 9.3mm (arrow wraps shall not be considered as part of this limitation as long they do not extend further than 22cm toward the point of the arrow when measured from the throat nock hole where the string sits of the nock to the end of the wrap); the tips (points) for these arrows may have a maximum diameter of 9.4mm. All arrows of every athlete shall be marked with the athlete's name or initials on the shaft. All arrows used in any end shall be identical and shall carry the same pattern and colour(s) of fletching, nocks and cresting, if any. Tracer nocks (electrically/electronically lighted arrow nocks) are not allowed.

ADULT AGE CLASSES and YOUTH AGE CLASSES:

- "Senior", (any age)
- "Masters 50+", (Born in or before 1963)
- "Masters 60+", (Born in or before 1953)
- "Masters 70+" (Born in or before 1943)
- "Junior" through the calendar year of their 20th birthday (Born in or after 1993)
- "Cadet" through the calendar year of their 17th birthday (Born in or after 1996)
- "Cub" through the calendar year of their 14th birthday (Born in or after 1999)
- "Bowman" through the calendar year of their 12th birthday (Born in or after 2001)

<u>WHEELCHAIR USERS:</u> Please check the box on the registration form, if you are a wheelchair user and remain on the shooting line during both lines of shooting. You will need to provide your own agent for scoring and pulling arrows.
