FORMAT: Single FITA I – Indoor 18 meter Tournament (Star FITA)

Bowman and Cub Classes,

***Saturday Only-Recurve Bow, FITA Bare bow and Genesis**- 60 arrows from 18 meters; - 60 cm target face single 10 ring target, outer 10 ring scoring.

****Compound Bow-** 60 arrows from 18 meters; - 40 cm target face (choice of single spot, triangle or vertical three-spot face; outer 10 ring scoring.)

Juniors and Cadets Classes,

*Saturday Only-Recurve Bow and FITA Bare bow - 60 arrows from 18 meters; - 40 cm target face (choice of single-spot, triangle or vertical three-spot face); outer 10 ring scoring. **Compound Bow- 60 arrows from 18 meters; - 40 cm target face (choice of single spot, triangle or vertical three-spot face; use inner 10 ring scoring.)

*Recurve archers will only be able to shoot on Saturday **Compound archers will have awards on Sunday and Overflow compound will shoot Saturday.

MEMBERSHIP – USAA/NAA membership listing Arizona residence is required to compete for the State Championship recognition. If your USAA membership expires prior to the official start date of the tournament, your application will not be considered complete until your current membership is on file with the USAA "YOU MUST BRING YOUR CURRENT USA ARCHERY MEMBERSHIP CARD TO TOURNAMENT CHECK-IN. YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE WITHOUT IT!"

Arrow Requirements (World Archery, Book 3):

11.1.7. Arrows of any type may be used provided they comply with the common meaning of the word "arrow" as used in target archery, and do not cause undue damage to target faces or butts.

11.1.7.1. An arrow consists of a shaft with a tip (point), nocks, fletching and, if desired, cresting. The maximum diameter of **arrow shafts shall not exceed 9.3mm** (arrow wraps shall not be considered as part of this limitation as long they do not extend further than 22cm toward the point of the arrow when measured from the throat – nock hole where the string sits – of the nock to the end of the wrap); **the tips (points) for these arrows may have a maximum diameter of 9.4mm.** All arrows of every athlete shall be marked with the athlete's name or initials on the shaft. All arrows used in any end shall be identical and shall carry the same pattern and colour(s) of fletching, nocks and cresting, if any. Tracer nocks (electrically/electronically lighted arrow nocks) are not allowed.

"Junior" through the calendar year of their 20th birthday (Born in or after 1994)

"Cadet" through the calendar year of their 17th birthday (Born in or after 1997)

"Cub" through the calendar year of their 14th birthday (Born in or after 2000)

"Bowman" through the calendar year of their 12th birthday (Born in or after 2002)
